The Regeneron International Science & Engineering Fair (ISEF) is the world's largest pre-college celebration of science. Held annually in May, ISEF brings together over 1,800 students from more than 75 nations to compete for scholarships, tuition grants, internships, scientific field trips and the grand prize, a \$75,000 college scholarship. You'll meet new friends, speak with Nobel Laureates and showcase your research on an international stage.

As a senior division participant of the Pittsburgh Regional Science & Engineering Fair (PRSEF), you may submit a preliminary application to attend ISEF.

GET INVOLVED! To be considered for ISEF, you must be registered as a Pittsburgh Regional Science & Engineering Fair participant in the senior division, submit a Preliminary ISEF Student Application Form along with one copy of your research paper and email your research paper to PRSEF@carnegiesciencecenter.org by February 26, 2021. Judges review these papers prior to PRSEF. Selected students will be interviewed on Fair Day. Final selection will be determined by a panel of judges. Winners will be announced during the Awards Ceremony the day after the fair. Winners must be available on or before April 2 for final paperwork submission to ISEF.
